## What is Global Citizenship Education?

It is a developing practice, which started from the need to deal with the changing international social and political situations, globalization, migration, multi-cultural societies and climate change, to name a few.

These 'global' issues have led many countries to develop practices known as "Global Citizenship Education". The methods used and the practices adopted in different countries are often not the same and not based on the same thinking.

We build educators' capacity to teach **Global Citizenship** to their students with the help of **digital storytelling** techniques.

We will also inform policy-makers and civil society on what Global Citizenship Education is and why it is important"
